Early notification of patients with testicular tumours is requested in order to facilitate their urgent review at Addenbrooke's. Patients will not be sent an appointment unless their histology is available and they have undergone a CT scan of the chest/abdomen/pelvis. Proper functioning of the MDM at Addenbrooke's means that slides and blocks should be forwarded to Dr R Moseley, Consultant Histopathologist, Box No 235, Addenbrooke's NHS Trust for review in all non-seminoma cases. All CT scans should be forwarded for review to Dr Michael Williams, Consultant Clinical Oncologist, Box No 193, Addenbrooke's NHS Trust. The films should include lung windows.
