

Dear Team

There continues to be confusion around referrals into urology TWOC clinics. To clarify: these clinics are for urology patients only and cannot be accessed by other specialities (including ED).

- Surgical patients (non-urology), have their own pathway and should only be referred to urology for urological issues regarding their AUR.
- Non-surgical patients: Lorraine Spindler and primary care offer TWOC services. If you are referred a patients you should assess whether there are any underlying urological issues and if they require a TWOC in our clinic, you will need to book the TWOC under the urology consultant on-call when you reviewed the patient.
- ED patients: ED can access primary care TWOCs or refer to urology and the patient will need to be seen by a member of our team who can then book them into a TWOC clinic as above.

Please make sure that there is clear evidence of your urological review, including DRE findings, residual etc.
